#### 1. Why is immersion important in baptism?

**Romans 6:1–3** NIV <sup>1</sup> What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? <sup>2</sup> By no means! We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? <sup>3</sup> Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

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Romans 6:4–8 NIV <sup>4</sup> We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. <sup>5</sup> For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his... <sup>8</sup> Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.

# Through baptism:

- 1. You bury the old self, and a new you comes up.
- 2. You place your faith in the death & resurrection of Christ.
- 3. You believe that, as Christ rose, you'll rise on the last day.
- 4. You confess that your new life is united with Christ.

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# 2. How should my life look like after baptism?

Romans 6:11–13 NIV <sup>11</sup> In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. <sup>12</sup> Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. <sup>13</sup> Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

Your life after baptism is:

- A life renouncing sin.
- A life devoted to righteousness.

### 3. What if I don't feel, or act, as a new person?

**Romans 6:14** NIV For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.

Romans 6:7 NIV because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.

**2 Corinthians 5:17 ESV** <sup>17</sup> Therefore, if anyone <u>is in Christ</u>, he is <u>a new creation</u>. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.
